Summer Sunscreen Tips



Dr. Porcia Love, a JLM member and Board Certified Dermatologist/ Clinical Assistant Professor for UAB Medicine, shared important sunscreen tips for a safe summer!

Love said, regardless of skin color, everyone needs to wear sunscreen! And don't forget about your feet (top/bottom), ears, back of neck, scalp and hands- these are often forgotten areas she sees that burn easily which can lead into pre-cancerous spots.

Health.com cited even more tips sun-lovers often forget:

- · Apply 30 minutes prior to going outside
- Apply sunscreen to lips (or wear lip balm with SPF)
- Don't leave sunscreen in the car (exposure to UV light and heat at 90* or above, the SPF actually diminishes, if not dissolves)
- · Wear sunscreen that is developed specifically for faces
