Women In Training Community Impact

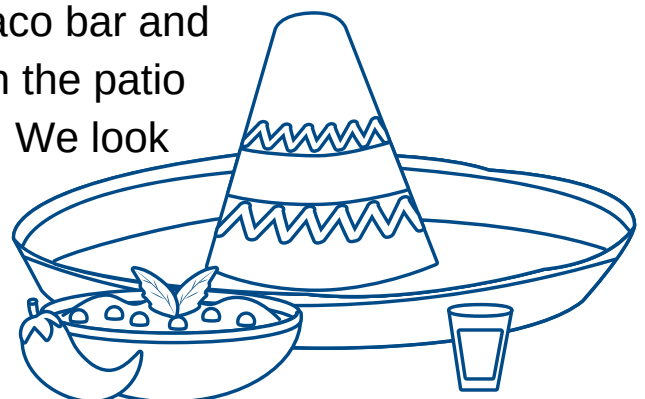
