Award announcements and check(s) will be presented to the selected applicant(s) at the May 2018 Junior League Membership Meeting. All applicants not selected for funding will be notified in writing by June 1, 2018.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD:

- Scholarships may be requested in the amount of \$250 and up to \$2,500.
- Requests may be fully or partially funded.
- Payment will be made directly to the scholarship recipient.
- A follow up report should be submitted to the Junior League of Montgomery by December 1, 2018.
- This is a one time award and will not be eligible for renewal.

TYPES OF SCHOLARSHIPS:

- General Operating Support for a business or non-profit organization
- Seed/Start up Grant for a business or non-profit organization
- Crisis Grant to cover unexpected expenses hindering the progress of a woman's education, business plan, or professional development
